Eligibility

The High School Art Competition is open to all art students at your high school.

The Jury

The show will be juried by the UT Martin Visual Arts Faculty.

Awards

The following will be awarded in each of the following four categories:

Painting/Mixed Media
Drawing
Printmaking/Photography
3-D Sculpture

1st Place — \$75 award
2nd Place — \$50 award
3rd Place — \$25 award

There will also be an award of \$100 for overall Best in Show.

Exhibit Requirements

All two-dimensional artwork must be matted and ready for hanging. Three-dimensional work must fit through a standard door and not exceed 150 pounds in weight.

Any work deemed to not meet strict exhibit criteria will not be considered for exhibition. All jury decisions are final.



Delivery of Artwork

All work needs to be delivered to the Fine Arts Office, 102 Fine Arts Building, on Friday, January 12th, 2007 to be considered for the competition. Work may be delivered at other times prior to January 12th by arrangement. Call 731-881-7417 or 7400 to arrange a specific delivery time. Entry in this exhibit releases UT Martin of any liability regarding students and their artwork. Students and faculty participating in College Art Day on Friday, January 19th may see their works on display and take part in the awards presentation.
